SCHOLARSHIPS and the HIGH PERFORMANCE PROGRAMMES (Music & Sport)

Cheadle Hulme School offers a small number of **scholarships** each year in recognition of outstanding performance or potential in a given area. Scholarships are non-means tested and offer a discount of up to 25% of the annual school fee. All awards are made at the discretion of the School.

- **Academic Scholarships** are awarded for outstanding performance in the Senior School Entrance Exam. There is no separate application process. These Awards are offered at the same time as the formal offer of a place at the School is made.
- A **Sports Scholarship** is awarded to a pupil who demonstrates outstanding sporting potential in a major sport which the School competes in. **If you wish your child to be considered for a Sports Scholarship please complete the relevant section below.**
- A **Music Scholarship** is awarded to a pupil who demonstrates outstanding potential in one or more musical instruments. **If you wish your child to be considered for a Music Scholarship please complete the relevant section below.**

A limited number of places are offered to pupils for our **High Performance Programmes (HPP)** in both **Music** and **Sport**. These specialist programmes provide additional developmental opportunities and bespoke support to pupils who demonstrate significant potential on the Audition/Assessment Day. **If you wish your child to be considered for an HPP place please complete the relevant section below.**

All offers are made at the discretion of the School and can be withdrawn if the pupil's progress, attitude or commitment is judged to be unsatisfactory.

Cheadle Hulme School has a long tradition, established at its founding in 1855, of providing financial support to talented and deserving young people, so that they can access the education and opportunities that the School offers.

Financial Assistance is given at the discretion of the Governing Body and is available to families:

- whose child is entering the Senior School;
- whose household's gross annual income (before tax and other deductions) is typically £60,000 or less;
- for whom the market value of all property and assets owned by the family is less than £350,000.

The offer of Financial Assistance will also take into account the child's academic achievements and ability and their potential to develop and benefit from taking part in the wider, co-curricular activities on offer at the School.

Financial Assistance ranges from 10% to 100% of the annual fee depending on the level of household income.
