

USE OF COOKIES

What are "cookies?"

Cookies are small text files that are stored on your computer, tablet or phone when you visit a website.

When do we collect cookies?

We collect cookies each time someone visits www.cheadlehulmeschool.co.uk

What information is collected?

Cookies collect anonymous information about how our website is used - for instance which pages are visited most. Using cookies helps us to improve our site and to deliver a better and more personalised service.

We use cookies that are essential to enable browsing of our website and to use its features. Without these cookies you would not be able to use the website to its full potential.

We may collect information about your computer, including where available your IP address, operating system and browser type, for system administration. This is statistical data about browsing actions and patterns and does not identify any individual.

Do I have to consent to cookies?

Cookie usage is enabled as standard on our website so we can give the very best experience. If you continue without changing these settings, you consent to this but if you want, you can change your cookie settings or turn them off via your web browser. If you do change your cookie settings our site may not work as intended and you may be unable to access certain parts of the site.
